Trail Usage Rules, Shuster Way Heritage Trail

Revised August 1, 2023

Trail Hours: Open Dawn to Dusk • Closed Dusk to Dawn

Trail Rules: (website & at trailheads)

- 1. Trail Hours: Open dawn to dusk. Closed dusk to dawn.
- 2. Dial 911 for emergencies.
- 3. Parking: (1) no overnight parking; (2) park only in designated areas; (3) parking only for trail users.
- 4. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES except for wheelchairs, scooters, and permitted e-bikes.
- 5. Permitted E-bike: Must weigh 100 pounds or less; has a motor that produces more 750 watts or less; and has fully functional pedals.
- 6. Speed limit: Not to Exceed 15 MPH.
- 7. Pedestrians have right of way.
- 8. Users must leash pets and remove pet waste.
- 9. Users must stay on designated trail.
- 10. Users must travel at speed appropriate to conditions and other users.
- 11. Users must use audible signals when passing.
- 12. Users must not fish from, jump from, or climb on structures.
- 13. Alcohol and psychoactive substances are prohibited.
- 14. Littering is prohibited.
- 15. Graffiti or otherwise making structures and objects is prohibited.
- 16. Open campfires and camping are prohibited.
- 17. Report trail maintenance concerns to Bedford Township Office (814-623-8296), or Borough Office (814-623-8805).
- Events involving more than 20 people require prior approval from the Bedford Joint Municipal Authority and Bedford Borough.
